Purpose

The *Information* tab is the first and highest-level data entry tab on the *Application - NameID* panel. Providers and requesters use it to do the following:

- Add a new application to the AIR database
- Open an existing AIR application to update or view the application's information
- Add a new application version

Usage Tips

- Enter the *Application Directory Group*, *Application Vendor*, and *Application Short Name* information in the **Application - Name** panel.
- Enter a unique name in the *Application Name* field.
- Enter one or more application search alias names, such as nicknames, a short descriptive phrase, or other key words GADS users might enter in the *AIR-Search* window to find this application.
- In the *Description* field, enter a concise and unique phrase (repeat the Application Name, if appropriate) that clearly identifies the application on the
